THAT arsenic and chromium are currently listed as ‘toxic’ under the *Canadian Environmental Protection Act, 1999*;

AND THAT there is increasing evidence that **Canadians and their environment are being poisoned by exposure to these compounds** through (among other things) the use and misuse of “Chromated Copper Arsenic (CCA) Pressure Treated Wood”;

THEREFORE, pursuant to the *Canadian Environmental Protection Act (CEPA)*, other relevant legislation, and relying on the application of the Precautionary Principle, your petitioners call upon Parliament to immediately **ban the use of these compounds in pressure treated wood products**.
